**Julie Hagen**  
1960 – 2025

Julie Hagen worked for the CPC for 28 years. She was an exceptional person in so many ways and extraordinarily gifted in her ministry work at the CPC. Her proficient medical skills, communication skills and passion for the gospel made her a precious gift.

Sadly, she was forced to discontinue her time at the CPC given her cancer diagnosis to focus on health issues as well as intentional family time.

Several months following that decision, we had our 2023 Spring Benefit. Lydia Rupp, Defiance office manager and fellow colleague shared a number of thoughts that seem appropriate to share here as well.

These past few months have been very hard and sad as we have adjusted to the sudden change without Julie and I miss her daily. I, along with our Defiance volunteers and I know everyone else on staff, have felt her absence deeply and spend many conversations talking about how wonderful Julie is and all that she brought into the centers.

She performed the ultrasound scans on these girls as well as further counseling. I want to recognize her for her many years of faithful work at CPC and the joy and wisdom she brought to our office. Her humility in her work was truly inspiring and convicting. She gave her all to being the hand and feet of Jesus at CPC. The way that she talked with clients was a privilege to witness – such winsomeness, love, boldness, and so clearly allowed the Spirit to lead. She had a way of connecting with even the hardest of clients and it was clear they felt loved by her. Julie is a servant leader in every way and became more like a friend and counselor to me personally than a coworker.

One of my favorite things to overhear is when Julie would find out that a client had accepted Christ as their Savior – she would exclaim “I thought I heard the angels rejoicing!!”

Julie always said she is the least qualified of people to be explaining the gospel to unbelievers, yet she knew there was no excuse in being unqualified to not simply and boldly share the love of Jesus. And she would encourage and remind each of us that we are to be obedient to the call as a Christian and hold high this privilege of speaking the good news to others. She truly delighted in it..

The ultrasound room was like her second home and some of my favorite moments with her at CPC was watching her perform a scan on a young client and recite Psalm 139 over that baby.

Lydia shared that one particular tearful client shared with Julie: “I am so glad I have my baby, I don’t know what I’d do without her. I would be a different person if I went through with that. I am so glad I went to the CPC. God saved my little girl.” This mother hugged her and thanked us repeatedly for the work we do.

Julie will be deeply missed and as Lydia said in thinking through many stories of their interactions, “only made me miss her more.”
