In a world filled with uncertainty, we remain committed to our mission—to affirm life, speak truth, and offer hope. By God's grace, and through the partnership of friends like you, lives are being changed. Your prayers, encouragement, and financial support have helped make this possible.

In just the first ten months of this year, we have seen God's faithfulness in beautiful and tangible ways:

- 168 babies were welcomed into the world
- 260+ ultrasounds were provided
- 284+ pregnancy tests administered
- 1,177+ gospel-centered conversations shared

Each number represents a **person**—a life protected, a mother encouraged, a family supported, and a heart pointed toward truth and hope. We give praise to God for every opportunity to serve.

We also rejoice in God's provision for our staffing needs this year. We welcomed a new Client Coordinator, an additional Nurse, and a Community Liaison—each one strengthening our ability to care for mothers and advocate for life. We also welcomed a new Project Respect Director, allowing us to meet increased requests from schools and share a life-affirming message with the next generation. We are better positioned than ever to meet the growing needs before us.

While we celebrate these blessings, we remain short by nearly -\$86,000 YTD between the CPC and Project Respect in meeting our ministry expenses. This is not uncommon at this time of year, and we do not lose heart. God has always been faithful, and we trust He will continue to provide. Yet, we also know He often meets needs through His people.




