

A SOBERING REALITY... BUT GOD

More recently, I was again reminded of a sobering reality—one that applies not only to our centers, but to the condition of the world as a whole. Apart from Christ, mankind is utterly lost. As Paul writes to Timothy, *“Evil men and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived”* (2 Timothy 3:13). Though written nearly two thousand years ago, those words ring with unmistakable clarity today, affirming the enduring truth of Scripture. We are witnessing an increasing rebellion against God, His Word, and all that upholds biblical truth.

We are also seeing a growing complexity in the challenges people face, often shaped by the decisions they make. It is a tangled and difficult landscape—one that requires deep wisdom and discernment to navigate, both for CPC staff and volunteers, as well as for the clients we serve. Yet we engage these moments with grace and mercy, speaking truth in love and relying on the strength that only God provides.

One staff member shared, *“With as many years as I’ve been doing this, you’d think I wouldn’t be surprised—but I still am.”* She even joked that her composure during a recent conversation might qualify her for an Oscar.

And yet, in the midst of it all, we hold fast to this redemptive truth: despite our sin, God graciously saves—even the worst of sinners, people like us. God, by His very nature, is a saving God. Paul says that *“in Christ God was reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation”* (2 Corinthians 5:19).

With grateful hearts, we recognize His work of not counting our sins against us. We must guard against the subtle temptation to view our sins as somehow less serious or more respectable. Scripture reminds us, *“God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us”* (Romans 5:8).





God rescues us from error to truth, from darkness to light, from death to life, from alienation to adoption, and from sin to righteousness. In Christ, we are freed from sin’s power and penalty, and one day, we will be freed from its very presence. Praise His name!

Until that day, sin remains a daily reality. It often proves easier to recognize in others than in ourselves. Yet this does not leave us without hope—far from it. The gospel of Jesus Christ offers forgiveness, redemption, regeneration, and new life. We aim to help every person who walks through our doors see that truth clearly—for their own heart and for the life of their unborn child.

We are deeply grateful for your faithful partnership in serving the Lord and His church alongside us. May He continue to encourage, equip, sanctify, and bless you as you grow in the grace and knowledge of the Lord Jesus (2 Peter 3:18).
